educast.nrw is a project that aims to enable and support digital video-based elearning for public higher education institutions in North Rhine-Westphalia and is funded by the state of North Rhine-Westphalia as part of the "Digitale Hochschule NRW" program. The educast.nrw video service cooperates with ORCA.nrw and supports the production and exchange of OER video content for participating institutions (educast.nrw, 2022).

Key features of educast include;

- The open source software Opencast is used for educast.nrw video recordings, via a plugin in Moodle.
- Videos of various file sizes can be uploaded directly via the educast plugin.
- Videos are created in a repository, sorted into so-called "series", and can be selected there.
- More than one series can be created per course.
- The repository is course-wide and not specific assigned to users.

Please note, unlike on YouTube, live streaming is not yet possible, therefore only pre-saved video files can be uploaded.

MURAL



MURAL is an online based whiteboard software, that can be utilized as a teaching tool in higher education. Cohorts of students can work collaboratively as a team, while using a visually attractive digital canvas.

Members of a cohort can work simultaneously together in different places, while the boards are shareable also.

As a teaching resource, this digital tool can be used, for example, to enable students to brainstorm solutions to their problems or challenges or to create simple but comprehensive diagrams and work on ideas virtually.

MURAL is free for educators.

The education workspace account includes the following key features:

- One workspace with open and private rooms.
- Unlimited murals.
- 25 external guests.
- Unlimited visitors no sign-in required.
- Up to 100 memberships.
- Live webinars and a dedicated space in the MURAL Community.

»Wir stärken Mädchen« - Podcast Project



In a team effort with Dr Maryam Bolouri, I currently support the »Wir stärken Mädchen« – Podcast Project of the Gesamtschule am Forstgarten, in Kleve.

Mrs Bothorn, the social education worker of the secondary school, started the project in line with the nation-wide initiative, which focuses on encouraging female students to investigate typically male dominated careers.

After Mrs Bothorn reached out to Dr Boulori earlier this year, we initially offered a two-part training on podcast production to a group of year 9 students, including the introduction of essential technology and tools, as well as sharing insights on best practices.

We are now in the process of editing the first episode of the podcast series, together with the group of students and their social education worker, utilizing the Technology and Bionics audio lab.

The overall aim is to teach the group how to record, edit and share the podcast, as well as how to promote it.
